

How the Flu Clinics will work:

- Please visit <https://visitingnurse.net/flu-vaccine-clinic/> Print out and complete a Consent/Registration Form and bring it with you to the flu clinic.
- The clinics are for those over the age of 4 years. Younger children should be taken to a pediatrician for a vaccination.
- The cost of a flu vaccine is \$55. High-dose vaccine is available for those over age 65 and the cost is \$75. We will bill directly to Medicare Part B, Aetna, Anthem, Connecticare or Harvard Pilgrim. Please bring your insurance card with you to the clinic.
- These are drive-through flu clinics and you must remain in your car at all times.
- Safety precautions will be taken to ensure a safe and healthy environment.
- A protective face mask that fits over your nose and mouth must be worn while on site at the flu clinics.
- Not pets in the car please!
- Please wear short sleeves or sleeves that can be easily rolled up. The nurse will administer the flu vaccine through the window of the car in the arm that is closest to her.
- Eat something before you arrive at the flu clinic.
- Bring water with you to the flu clinic.
- Although delays may be possible due to high demand, we will make every effort to move you through the flu clinic as quickly as possible.
